25 Yard, Timed Finals

Meet Management may opt to use fly-over starts at this competition.

To maintain an adequate timeline, start times may be adjusted slightly earlier based on entries submitted.

Eligibility:

Open to all current CCS members who meet the CCS eligibility criteria. See CCS Governance Handbook for more details concerning eligibility.

Pool Specifications:

Outdoor heated pool with one certified 8 lane 25-yard competition course with non-turbulent lane lines. Water depth at the competition starting and turn end is a minimum of 8 feet. Continuous warm up will be available throughout the meet in the adjacent 11 lanes.

Timing:

Fully automatic Omega timing system with viviLED full video scoreboard. Hy-tek meet manager will be used to score the meet.

Entries:

Swimmers may enter a maximum of 5 individual events.

No penalty for scratches on the block for pre-seeded events.

25 SCY Times will be used for seeding.

Events will be seeded fastest to slowest.

No "no time" (NT) entries will be accepted.

No deck entries will be accepted.

Entries must be submitted via CCS Online Meet Entry System.

Positive Check-in/Deck Seeded Events:

The following events will be deck seeded and will require positive check-in by 45 minutes prior to the start of the session.

400 IM 500 Freestyle 1000 Freestyle 400 Medley Relay 400 Freestyle Relay

Swimmers entered and checked in for a deck seeded event must swim that event unless he/she notifies the clerk of course, before seeding begins, that he/she wishes to scratch that event. Failure to do so will result in the swimmer being barred from his/her next individual event on that day or the next, whichever is first.

No penalty shall apply for failure to withdraw or compete in a deck seeded event if:

- 1. The referee is notified in the event of illness or injury and accepts the proof thereof.
- 2. It is determined by the referee that failure to compete is caused by circumstances beyond the control of the swimmer.

Relays:

Only two teams may be submitted for each relay event (A and B team). Only the A relays will score points. There is no limit to how many relays an individual swimmer can enter.

Entry Fee:

\$21.50 per swimmer

Fees will be collected through CCS Online Entry System.

Once confirmation period closes teams are responsible for paying their 100% of the fees associated with their entries. No exceptions will be made to participants that are unable to attend after the confirmation period closes.

Entry Deadline:

Athlete entries must be submitted through CCS Online Meet Entry System by Friday, November 4^{th} @ 11:59pm.

Confirmation Period: Saturday, November 5th @ 12:00am to Sunday, November 6th @ 11:59pm Officers may modify entries and must enter relays during the confirmation period. Late entries (submitted after the confirmation period closes) will incur a \$100 fine. Once the psych sheet is posted officers have 24 hours to correct any errors. This does not include any new entries or changes. Any new entries or changes made during this time will incur the \$100 late fine. No late entries will be accepted once seeding begins.

Team Representative:

Upon arrival to the competition, each team must submit one representative (president, officer, etc.) to confirm payment and collect heat sheets and relay cards. An on-deck meeting may take place prior to the start of each session to provide any last-minute information.

Meet Communication:

Important information regarding arrival logistics, meet procedures, social events, and more will be shared in the officers GroupMe (contact us to be added), in the CCS Discord, and by email.

Awards:

Plaques will be awarded to the top two men's, women's, and combined team finishers.

Rules:

Current USMS Swimming Rules & Regulations will govern.

Parking:

Available parking will be located across from Morcom Aquatics Center at the WFSU building and the College of Engineering. NO PARKING is allowed in the Morcom lots, at the tennis facility, at the golf course, or along Pottsdamer St. A detailed map and instructions will be sent to clubs prior to the meet. There is no fee for parking.

Spectators:

Spectators will be permitted in the venue in designated seating. There is no admission fee.

SWIMS Notice:

This meet is being observed by Florida Swimming of USA Swimming. Swimmers entered in the meet who want to have their times be recorded in the USA Swimming SWIMS database must ensure that their CCS profile contains their first name, last name, and birthdate as recorded on their USA Swimming profile. (Those that go by nicknames or middle names will want to verify this). You must also ensure, if you are requesting observation, that your USA registration is current and in good standing. Please send a list of your swimmers requesting USA Observation to fsuswimclub@gmail.com by the entry deadline. If a swimmer has any issues regarding accessing your USA information, please contact us and we will work with them individually.

- Lane 4. Swimming and pulling, push off
- Lane 5. Swimming and pulling, push off
- Lane 6. Racing starts (one length from start end only)
- Lane 7. Racing starts (one length from start end only)
- Lane 8. Pace 50 and 100 circle swimming push off
